- I. Call to Order. Chairman Noblet called the meeting to order at 5:30p.m.
- II. Oath of office for new Commissioner. District Secretary Sarah Pedersen swore in Jim Towers as Commissioner Position #1.
- III. Approval of Agenda. Commissioner Mestemacher made a motion to approve the agenda as presented; Commissioner Towers seconded.
- IV. Public Input. Savannah Erickson, Commissioner-Elect for Position #3, introduced herself to the Board and the audience.
- V. Consent Agenda All matters listed within the Consent Agenda have been distributed to each member of South Whidbey Fire/EMS's Board of Commissioners for reading and study. They are considered to be routine, and will be enacted by one motion of the Commissioners with no separate discussion. VI. Unfinished Business –

a. 2022 Budget Presentation. Chief Palmer stated that there has been one change since the first reading at the last meeting; The District received its three vehicles that were not expected to be received until 2022. These will be paid for this year. Chief Palmer explained how the District's revenues are expended into our internal funds, The District's bond payment, and the budget process. Commissioner Towers asked a question regarding overtime; Chief Palmer stated that we should have enough budgeted for the remainder of the year.

- a. Resolution 2021-13 Levy Certification. Finance Officer Sarah Pedersen explained the Resolution and items needing to be filed with the County by November 30th. Commissioner Mestemacher encouraged the new and existing Commissioners to attend as many Commissioner conferences and trainings as they can, as the information they provide is very helpful. Chief Palmer stated that he has reached out to our District Attorney to see if he would be able to do a 2-3 hour training session with the Board in January regarding laws and policies.
